# Nominations being accepted for “Outstanding Military Veteran”

Nominations are now being accepted for Henry County’s “Outstanding Military Veteran” award for 2012.

The award will go to the nominee judged by the Board of Supervisors to best represent what service to the country and to the community means. The award is patterned after Henry County’s popular Jack Dalton Community Service Award and was created at the suggestion of Board of Supervisors member Debra Buchanan.

The winners of the inaugural award in 2009 were David Kipfinger and James Rogers. The 2010 recipient was Olaf Hurd, while Donald James Myers won the honor in 2011.

Nomination forms are available from the County’s website – [www.henrycountyva.gov](http://www.henrycountyva.gov) – and from the County Administrator’s office. All nominations must be submitted on the nominating form and must be received by 5 p.m. on Friday, October 5.

Nominees will be judged by the Board of Supervisors based on the nominees’ military service and their community service. The award winner will be recognized during a Veterans Day ceremony on Sunday, November 11 at 2 p.m. at Bassett High School. Veterans Day is November 11.
