

HENRY COUNTY PUBLIC SERVICE AUTHORITY

PURSUANT to §15.2-5136 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, the Henry County Public Service Authority hereby gives notice of a PUBLIC HEARING scheduled for 7 p.m. on the 20th day of May 2013, in the Summerlin meeting room of the Henry County Administration Building on Kings Mountain Road, Collinsville, VA.

The purpose of this meeting will be to afford all users of Henry County Public Service Authority facilities, owners, tenants, or occupants of property served by the Henry County Public Service Authority facilities and all others interested to be heard concerning the proposed rates, fees and changes set out below and adopted by resolution of the Henry County Public Service Authority Board of Directors setting forth the proposed schedule fixing and classifying the rates, fees and changes at a duly called meeting for the Henry County Public Service Authority on the 18th day of March 2013.

SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES

- §15. WATER SERVICE.
- 15.01 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS. Unchanged.
- 15.02 FACILITY, CONNECTION AND INSPECTION CHARGES. Facility and connection charges will vary, depending on the size of the meter used.
- A ¾-inch meter will have a connection fee of \$1000 and a facility fee of \$750.
 - A 1-inch meter will have a connection fee of \$1200 and a facility fee of \$1500.
 - A 1½-inch meter will have a PSA cost based connection fee and a facility fee of \$10,000.
 - A 2-inch meter will have a PSA cost based connection fee and a facility fee of \$16,000.
 - A 3-inch meter will have a PSA cost based connection fee and a facility fee of \$30,000.
 - A 4-inch meter will have a PSA cost based connection fee and a facility fee of \$50,000.
 - A 6-inch meter will have a PSA cost based connection fee and a facility fee of \$100,000.
- A New Account Charge of \$25 will include the inspection fee.
- 15.03 WATER MAIN EXTENSIONS. Unchanged.
- 15.04 SERVICE CHARGES. All water service customers shall be subject to the payment of a minimum monthly service charge. A service active for less than one month's billing period shall be subject to the minimum rate or the metered rate, whichever is larger. All service charges are payable monthly.
- (a) Residential User. The minimum monthly water service charge per single family residential unit or equivalent shall be \$30 per month for the first 4,000 gallons and shall be based upon the actual water consumed. Thereafter, additional water consumed shall be charged at the rate of \$4.70 per 1,000 gallons.
 - (b) Non-Residential User. The minimum monthly water service charge per non-residential unit or equivalent shall be \$45 per month for the first 4,000 gallons and shall be based upon the actual water consumed. Thereafter, additional water consumed shall be charged at the rate of \$7.00 per 1,000 gallons.
 - (c) Institutional User. The minimum monthly water service per institutional unit or equivalent shall be \$68.50 per month for the 6,000 gallons and shall be based upon the actual water consumed. Thereafter, additional water consumed shall be charged at the rate of \$8.10 per 1,000 gallons.
 - (d) Non-User Service Charge – Unchanged.
 - (e) Grace Period and Penalty – Unchanged.
 - (f) Fire Protection Service. Unchanged.
 - (g) Miscellaneous Charges. Unchanged.

The rates and charges set by the Authority at such public hearing shall be deemed to apply to any and all existing water customers that are served by the Authority on and after June 1, 2013.

- §14. SANITARY SEWERAGE SERVICE.
- 14.01 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS. Unchanged.
- 14.02 FACILITY, CONNECTION AND INSPECTION CHARGES. Facility and connection charges will vary, depending on the size of the meter used. A 4-inch sewer lateral will have a connection fee of \$1000 and a 6-inch lateral will have a connection fee of \$1200. A ¾-inch meter will have a sewer facility fee of \$750. A 1-inch meter will have a facility fee of \$1500. A 1½-inch meter will have a facility fee of \$11,000. A 2-inch meter will have a facility fee of \$17,600. A 3-inch meter will have a facility fee of \$33,000. A 4-inch meter will have a facility fee of \$55,000. A 6-inch meter will have a facility fee of \$110,000. A New Account Charge of \$25 will include the inspection fee.
- 14.03 SEWER EXTENSIONS. Unchanged.
- 14.04 SERVICE CHARGES. All sewer service customers shall be subject to the payment of a monthly minimum service charge. A service active for less than one month's billing period shall be subject to the minimum rate or the metered rate, whichever is larger. All service charges are payable monthly.
- (a) Residential User. The minimum monthly sewer service charge per single family residential unit or equivalent shall be \$30 per month for the first 4,000 gallons and shall be based upon the actual water consumed. Thereafter, additional water consumed shall be charged at the rate of \$4.70 per 1,000 gallons.
- (b) Non-Residential User. The minimum monthly sewer service charge per non-residential unit or equivalent shall be \$45 per month for the first 4,000 gallons and shall be based upon the actual water consumed. Thereafter, additional water consumed shall be charged at the rate of \$7.00 per 1,000 gallons.
- (c) Institutional User. The minimum monthly water service per institutional unit or equivalent shall be \$68.50 per month for the 6,000 gallons and shall be based upon the actual water consumed. Thereafter, additional water consumed shall be charged at the rate of \$8.10 per 1,000 gallons.
- (d) Reduction in Sewer Charges– Unchanged.
- (e) Septage Charges – Unchanged.
- (f) Surcharge Requirements – Unchanged.
- (g) Non-User Service Charge – Unchanged.
- (h) Grace Period and Penalty – Unchanged.

The rates and charges set by the Authority at such public hearing shall deemed to apply to any and all existing sewerage customers who are served by the Authority on and after June 1, 2013.
