## **General Overview:**

The Henry County School Division is soliciting bids for Interactive Whiteboards, Interactive Projectors, and Interactive Flat Panels. Listed below are the minimum specifications for the software, interactive projectors, and interactive boards/flat panel. Please only submit bids for items that meet the minimum specifications listed below.

## **Software Minimum Specifications:**

- Interactive display software must include an interactive activity builder that allows users to create activities where objects react to actions by accepting or rejecting other objects and by triggering animations or sound.
- Teachers can create custom dynamic lesson activities to align with curriculum, capture student attention, and provide more immersive learning.
- Must be able to import and export PowerPoint® and Interactive Whiteboard/Common File Format (IWB/CFF) files.
- Teachers can easily import pre-created lesson activities to reduce up-front work on lesson creation.
- Must be able to insert tables into the interactive display software. These tables must be able to be converted from hand drawn tables or be used preformatted.
- Users, particularly those in STEM classrooms, can easily organize and present hand-drawn notes and values.
- Must be able to group pages that correlate to specific lesson plan activities and schedules. Lessons must be able to be broken down into segments for better organization of curriculum content.
- Users can adjust lesson material on the fly, allowing for more effective scaffolding of information and concepts.
- Interactive display software must include a properties tab that allows for modification of text style, object animation, fill effects, line style and page recording. Users can customize lesson activities to suit the needs of specific learners and educators.

## **Interactive Projectors Minimum Specifications:**

- Must support both pen and finger touch interaction.
