GENERAL LEAGUE GUIDELINES

- 1. Practice and regular season games may be held Monday through Saturday. There are usually two games per week, but some weeks there may be only one game and some weeks there could be as many as four games.
- 2. Parents are responsible for their child's transportation to and from games and practices. <u>Players will not be assigned to a specific team for ride arrangements.</u>
- 3. Practice begins in August. League play begins in September and will continue through November.
- 4. A parental consent card and a \$10.00 participation fee must be turned into the coach at the first practice. The participation fee is not refundable once paid. There is also a uniform fee for the Spirit Squads of \$40.00.
- 5. Any returning players that are age eligible will return to the same team as last year.
- 6. Parks & Recreation will draft all new players through a blind draft procedure.
- 7. All players (new and returning) must complete this registration form.
- 8. Players registering late will not automatically return to the same team as the previous year.
- 9. All children must play for the school that they attend or the school district in which they live. Children must live in Henry County, or attend a Henry County Public School in order to participate in this league.
- 10. This league is provided for the children to have fun, learn athletic skills, have social interaction, and develop life skills. Henry County Parks & Recreation has a code of ethics for coaches, parents, and participants. As a parent, you will be expected to behave in an appropriate manner at all games and practices. Parents who behave in an inappropriate manner will cause their child to be dismissed from the league. You should contact HCPR if you have a question as to what constitutes appropriate behavior.
