

The Henry County Electoral Board met Monday, September 8, 2020 at 10 AM, Room 3 Henry County Administration Building.

Rita Shropshire, Chairman called the meeting to order at 10 AM, Minutes of the last meeting June 23, 2020, were read and accepted.

Discussion regarding election law changes, to include early voting, September 18, 2020, absentee ballots requested by September 18, 2020, must be mailed by September 19, 45 days before November 3 and ballot bag were discussed for compliance.

Elizabeth Stone, Registrar, reported approximately 2600 absentee ballot requests have been received.

The Board reviewed the precinct Officers of Election. Agreed to contact Officers for confirmation for November 3 election and /or working early voting. Also to continue recruitment of new Officers of Election.

Precincts were divided by Board members.

Officer of Election training will be October 20, 21, 22 6PM-9PM.

Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs at 7PM.

Elizabeth Stone reported state is providing PPE and cleaning supplies. Plexiglass shields (2) per precincts have been ordered.

Voting machines for early voting, September 18, 2020 will have L&A testing September 14, 2020.

Elizabeth Stone reported the CAP has been scheduled to preprocess absentee ballots October 1, 8, 14, 15, 21, 22, 28, 29, 30, November 2, 3, 4, 4, and 5.

Meeting adjourned at noon.
