

The Henry County Electoral Board met at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 22, 2020 in the Registrar's Office.

Ellen Boone, Chairman called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The Board counted 2,500 Official Ballots to be used for Absentee Voting in the March 3, 2020 Democratic Presidential Election. The Vendor will send ballots for the polling places at a later date.

The Board appointed Officers of Election to serve on March 3, 2020 for the Democratic Presidential Primary. A letter was mailed to all Officers that had been Sworn-In for the year 2020 with a note to let the Registrar know by February 5th if he or she was unable to serve on March 3rd.

A Training Meeting will be held at 6:00 p.m. on February 20, 2020 for Officers of Election working in the Democratic Primary. A snow date for the training meeting was set for February 27th at 6:00 p.m.

The Registrar informed the Board that she had asked for assistance from the Henry County Sheriff's Office in the event of snow or sleet on election day. Sheriff Perry informed her to watch the weather forecast and let him know just as soon as possible and there is a possibility that he could get citizens with four wheel drives to pick up Officers of Election on election morning.

The Custodian of Voting Machines will begin Programming the Scanners on Monday, February 3, 2020. Rita Shropshire, Secretary will assist the Custodian.

There being no further business for discussion the meeting adjourned at 11:45 a.m.
