

The Henry County Electoral Board met Wednesday, August 3, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. in the Registrar's Office.

The Meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Ellen M. Boone. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The Board received new Election Law Books reflecting the 2016 Law Changes.

Restoration of Civil Rights was discussed. Governor McAuliffe restored the rights of approximately 206,000 Virginia Felons on April 22, May 31 and June 24, 2016. Henry County had added 88 people before the State Supreme Court overturned the decision on July 22, 2016. All 88 voters were removed from the voter rolls. The Board was concerned that some of the voters would not receive a cancellation notice before election day. Steven Donahoe made a motion, seconded by Ellen Boone, and the motion carried to allow the voter to cast a Provisional Ballot if the voter did not receive a cancellation notice due to an address change.


The Board completed the Annual General Registrar Performance Review of Registrar Elizabeth Stone. The Registrar was rated Exceptional.

The three members of the Board were handed a packet to study for training all Officers of Election that will work at the 25 Precincts on November 8, 2016.

The list of Officers of Election serving on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 was reviewed and updated.

David Bowyer, Voting Machine Technician, gave instructions on properly programming and setting up the new voting machines. The Board asked for his assistance in holding additional training sessions for new Officers of Election and a refresher course for the Chief and Assistant Chief of the 25 Precincts.

There being no further business for discussion the meeting adjourned at 12:30 p.m.
