


PHILPOTT MARINA - BOAT SEWAGE PUMP-OUT FACILITY HENRY COUNTY, VIRGINIA

GENERAL CONSTRUCTION NOTES:

- THIS PROJECT INVOLVES INSTALLATION OF ONE (1) BOAT SEWAGE PUMP-OUT SYSTEM TO BE LOCATED ON THE EXISTING PHILPOTT MARINA FLOATING DOCK. THE COMPLETED SYSTEM SHALL INCLUDE ONE (1) PERISTALTIC PUMP WITH LEAK DETECTION SHUTDOWN, CONTROL PANEL, 30' SUCTION HOSE, AND OTHER ITEMS INDICATED ON THESE PLANS. THE PUMP SHALL BE EQUAL TO KECO SERIES 900.M34-D, 2.0 HP, 120V, SINGLE PHASE, WITH TEFC ELECTRICAL MOTOR AND CAPABLE OF PUMPING UP TO 18 GPM @ 103' TDH AND 29' SUCTION LIFT. THE PUMP ASSEMBLY SHALL BE PROVIDED WITH A 2" QUICK CONNECT COUPLING AND SUFFICIENT LENGTH OF 2" DISCHARGE HOSE TO EXTEND FROM PUMP TO DISCHARGE LOCATION WITH NO SPLICES. DISCHARGE HOSE SHALL BE INSTALLED INSIDE PVC CONDUIT. THE PIPE CONDUIT SHALL BE SECURED SO AS TO PREVENT MOVEMENT OF THE PIPE AT ALL TIMES, INCLUDING PUMP STARTUP/SHUTOFF.
- ALL CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE COORDINATED WITH THE HENRY COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENGINEERING (276-634-4776) AND DEPARTMENT OF PARKS & RECREATION (276-634-4640).

ALL CONSTRUCTION UNDER THESE SPECIFICATIONS SHALL BE FREE FROM DEFECTS IN MATERIAL OR WORKMANSHIP, AND THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REPAIR OR REPLACE AT HIS EXPENSE ANY SUCH DEFECTIVE ITEMS DURING THE WARRANTY PERIOD. - INSTALLATION OF THE PUMP EQUIPMENT SHALL BE DONE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS PROVIDED BY THE MANUFACTURER.
- OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE MANUALS SHALL BE FURNISHED TO THE OWNER, WHICH WILL INCLUDE PARTS LISTS OF COMPONENTS AND COMPLETE SERVICE PROCEDURES AND TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE.











