

PARK FACILITIES

Jack Dalton Park
130 Jack Dalton Rd (Behind the Henry County Administration Building). This is a great park for a multitude of recreation activities. The picnic pavilion here is the largest and most popular in our parks system. The 6/10 mile paved lighted walking track is a great place to walk or jog and is open 24 hours a day.
- 2

Collinsville Jaycee Park
475 Parkwood Court (Off of King's Mountain Rd). Children will enjoy the two playgrounds at this park and folks of all ages can hike the 1.25 miles of wooded trails. Tennis players will enjoy using the lighted courts in this park. The two picnic pavilions here are great for birthday parties, family reunions and other events. This is especially a great place in the summer as the wooded setting provides for a cooler atmosphere.

Jordan Creek Park
243 Creekside Dr (Off of Carver Rd). This park is popular throughout the year for youth baseball and flag football teams. Children will enjoy the swings and playground and the picnic pavilion is a great place to have your church or family event.

Doe Run Park
270 Dupont Rd With two hiking trails, pond, creek and abundant wildlife, Doe Run Park is a nature lover's paradise. This park is a great year round destination and offers something different with each season.

Fieldale Park
11 Field Ave. Located in the heart of Fieldale, this park is a great place to play a pickup game of baseball or have a gathering at the picnic pavilion.
- 6

Fisher Farm Park
475 Leisure Trail (Located off of Old Mill Road in Ridgeway). At 127 acres, this is the largest park in our system. Much of this park is wooded and provides a great place to explore nature. Two picnic pavilions are available for a variety of events and the playground and swings here are great for children.
- 7

Gravelly Nature Preserve
2525 Eggleston Falls Rd (Located at the intersection of Eggleston Falls and Old Mill Rd). This beautiful park located next to the Smith River has several miles of hiking trails, a historic cemetery and picnic pavilion.
- 8

Mt Olivet Ruritan Field
400 Ward Rd (Located off of 57 East) This full size baseball/softball field is great for children and adults and is located directly behind the Mt. Olivet Ruritan Club.
- 9

Horsepasture Ruritan
16209 AL Philpott Hwy (Located on 58 West, a short distance from the bypass) This lighted baseball field is in the Horsepasture area of Henry County and is adjacent to the Horsepasture Ruritan Building.

Samuel H. Hairston
400 Samuel Hairston School Rd. This field is located directly in front of the old Samuel H. Hairston School in the Preston area of Henry County. This field is open to the public.
- 11

Lauren Mountain Preserve
200 Wells Hollow Road. These beautiful hiking trails border the Smith River and visitors can enjoy a peaceful retreat.

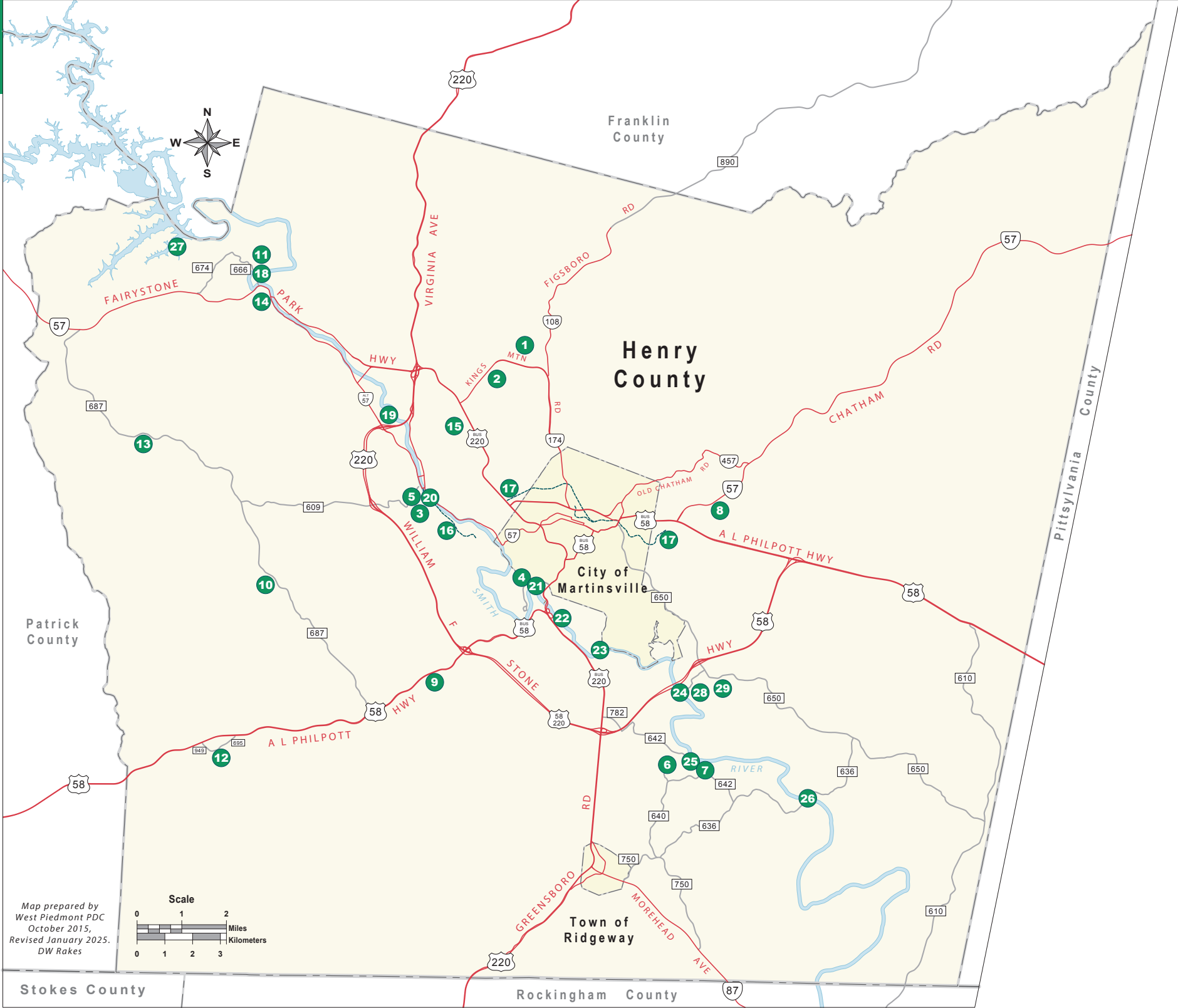

Spencer-Penn Park
30 George Taylor Rd. This mini park has a baseball field and playground and is located in Spencer next to the Spencer-Penn Centre. This is the site of the former Spencer-Penn School.
- 13

Sanville Ruritan Field
3541 Stones Dairy Rd. This newly renovated field is great for baseball and softball and is located in the heart of the Sanville Community.
- 14

Blackberry Park
Intersection of Rt 57 and 57A. This mini park is located between the Bassett Library and the old John D. Bassett School and has a playground and baseball/softball field.
- 15

Henry County Recreation Center
This facility features activity rooms, pickleball courts, kitchen, gym and dog park.
- 16

Fieldale / Textile Heritage Trails
3521 River Rd. This 2.5 mile walking trail is located on the right side of the Smith River in the heart of Fieldale. Walkers can enjoy seeing a variety of plant life, animals and of course the beautiful Smith River. Most of the trail is shaded and can be enjoyed year round.
- 17

Dick & Willie Trail
This 11 mile paved trail follows the path of the old Danville & Western Railway. The trail begins at the Smith River Sports Complex and continues through Martinsville and Henry County to the current end at the Virginia Avenue Trailhead. This is a great trail for walking, running, rollerblading and biking.

- 18

Bassett River Access
271 Trent Hill Dr (Off on Route 57 E in Bassett). Of the nine river access points that are operated by Henry County Parks & Recreation, this is the most northern access. Boaters that put in here have the choice of taking out at one of three other points south on the river.
- 19

Great Road River Access
4313 The Great Road (Across from Eastman). This wide access is great for getting off the river and for putting your boat on for travel further south.
- 20

Fieldale River Access
3521 River Rd. This access is located at the trailhead for the Fieldale Walking Trail. Plenty of parking is available. This is a nice location to plan a day trip & enjoy a hiking/boating adventure.
- 21

Doe Run River Access
303 DuPont Rd. This is the last access going south on the river before the Martinsville Dam. Boaters traveling south on the river will need to take out here. This is a calm part of the river and is a good spot to paddle in.
- 22

South Martinsville River Access
280 Tensbury Dr (at the Indian Heritage RV Park). This is the first access located below the Martinsville Dam and boaters getting on the river here will have several options to take out further south on the river.
- 23

Frith Drive River Access
23 Frith Dr. Our newest access point is a great spot for a short trip from South Martinsville or going to the Sports Complex.

- 24

Sports Complex River Access
1000 Irisburg Rd (Located at the Smith River Sports Complex). Boaters can enjoy this destination location at the Smith River Sports Complex. Whether getting on or off the river, this is a beautiful section and boaters can also enjoy the many amenities of the sports complex.
- 25

Marrowbone River Access
2120 Eggleston Falls Rd. Marrowbone Falls, which is just below this access, is considered by many boaters to be the nicest section of the Smith River for kayaking.
- 26

Mitchell Bridge River Access
2404 Mitchell Rd. Mitchell Bridge is the last public access in Henry County. This is a wide and beautiful section of the river and the access on the left side is easy to get to. If they wish, boaters can put in here and take out in North Carolina.
- 27

Philpott Marina
300 Boat Dock Rd. Philpott Marina is located on beautiful Philpott Lake. The full service marina offers yearly boat slip rentals, fuel sales, fishing supplies, drinks, snacks and restrooms. The facility also features a newly renovated 10 space group campground complete with water, electric and sewer hookups and a bath house.
- 28

Smith River Sports Complex
1000 Irisburg Road. The park features six fields, golf driving range, playground, fitness station, Dick and Willie Trail, picnic shelters and dog park.
- 29

Riverview Park (coming soon)
1080 Irisburg Road. This newest park facility is in the design stage and will feature some exciting new recreation amenities that are not currently available in the area.

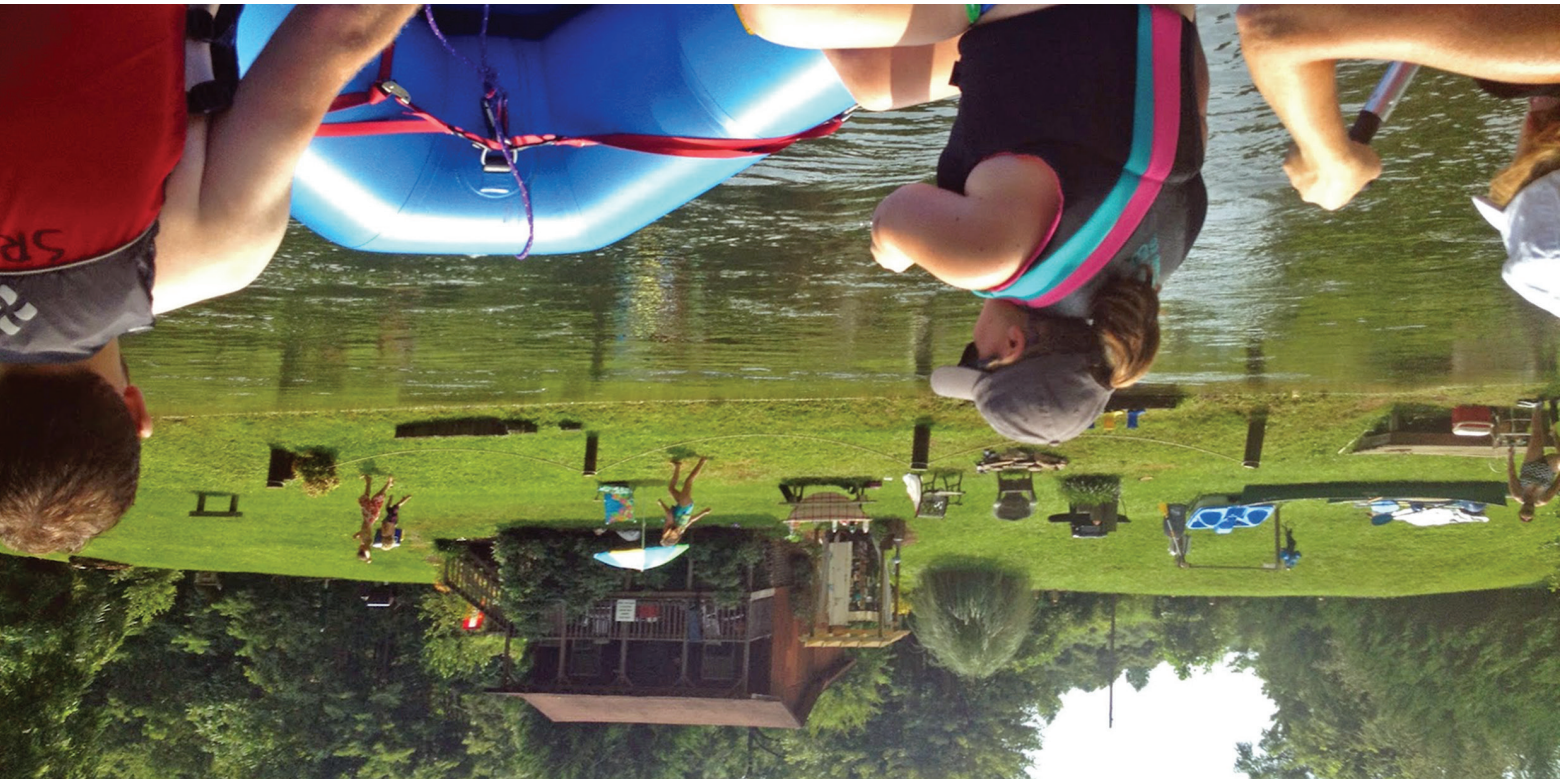
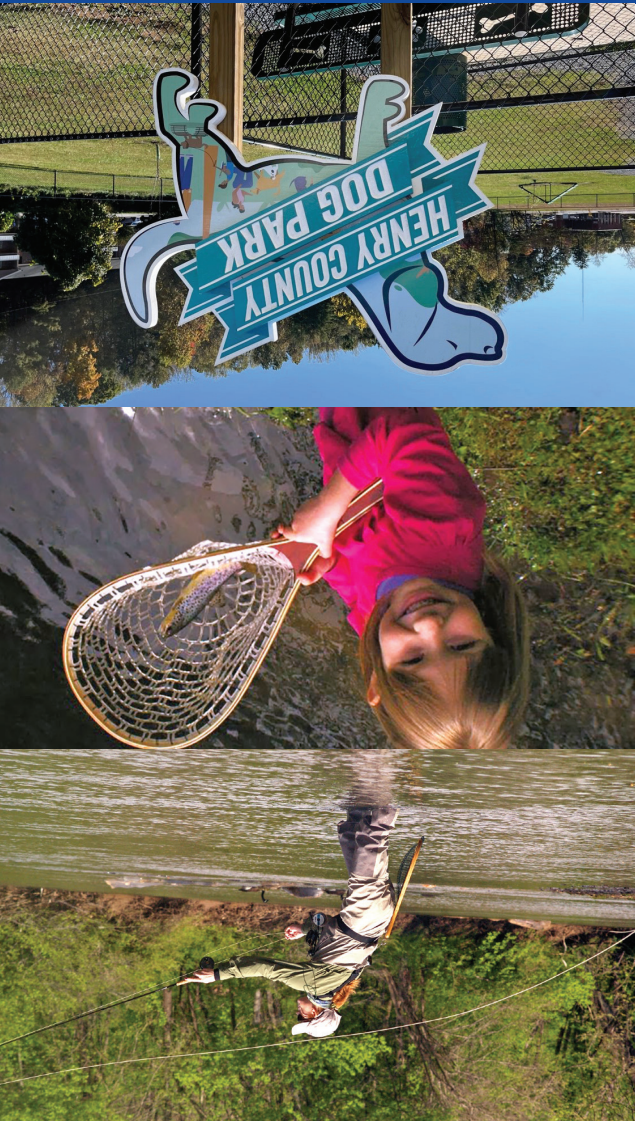
The parks in Henry County are a great place to relax, enjoy nature, go for a hike, have a cookout, take part in a baseball game and enjoy many other outdoor activities. People of all ages can enjoy these amenities any time of the year, as the parks are open every day of the year.

Facility Reservation Guidelines

- Parks are open from 8:00am until 10:00pm.
- Fisher Farm Park closes at dark.
- Reservations can be made 6 months to the day ahead of time.
- Pets must be on leashes at all times.
- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in any parks.
- Motorized vehicles must stay on asphalt/gravel.
- There are no refunds on park reservations.
- Users must take their reservation card with them.
- Please leave the shelter in good condition for next user.

The following activities are NOT allowed in the parks:

- Washing cars
- Camping (except at Philpott Marina Group Campground)
- Hitting golf balls
- Flying power-motored aircraft, rockets or gliders (except at Patriot Flying Field)
- Water balloons



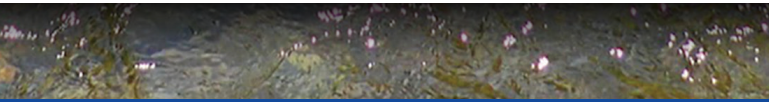
If your family is planning a special event, the Henry County Parks and Recreation Shelters located at our parks make great locations for gatherings.
